Share your Migraine Pain

Your provider will want to know how often you experience pain, pain level, how it affects your life, and what you've tried to manage the pain. It's helpful to think about:

- Is your headache pain impacting your life more than you thought?
- Are you satisfied with your current treatment plan?
- Are you interested in trying a non-drug treatment option?

What is CEFALY?

CEFALY is the first FDA-Cleared medical device of its kind for the treatment of migraine. It is cleared for:

- The acute treatment of migraine with or without aura in patients 18 years of age or older.
- The preventative treatment of episodic migraine in patients 18 years of age or older.

How Does it Work?

CEFALY is an External Trigeminal Nerve Stimulation device (e-TNS) that sends tiny impulses through an electrode positioned on the forehead to modify pain transmission and dissentatize the trigeminal nerve, reducing the frequency and intensity of migraine attacks.
